Leave it to the most progressive breweries to do a progressive dinner. June 11, 40 lucky beer-swilling souls dive into a four-course meal – at three restaurants – with prime pairings: Think ale and fennel sausage stuffed chicken wings and mini prawn tacos with 40 Acre Pale Ale and Pacific Street Raspberry Wheat at Peter B's, in the brand new barrel room; hoisin-braised short rib banh mi with Minespeeper at Alvarado Street Brewing; and boudin noir-stuffed pork tenderloin wrapped in Baker's double-smoked bacon with Scotch Ale by both ASB and Peter B's at Montrio Bistro. And that's just a partial menu.
